


Marking Rooms "Clean" or "Dirty"

To mark a room "Clean" or "Dirty" from the Tape Chart, first look on the left hand side of the page at the room numbers listed with the room type in parentheses.

If the cell is **yellow**, then the room is dirty, if it is **blue** it is clean.

- Click on the Room in the left column of the Tape Chart and a pop-out window will open with options.
- Click on **Mark Clean** or **Mark Dirty**
